

July 1, 2010

An organizational meeting of the Council of the City of Martinsville, Virginia, was held on July 1, 2010, in Council Chambers, Municipal Building, beginning at 9:00 A. M., with Ashby Pritchett, Circuit Court Clerk, presiding. Council Members present included: Kimble Reynolds, Jr., Gene Teague, Mark C. Stroud, Sr., Kim Adkins, and Danny Turner.

Pastor James C. Richardson of Mt. Sinai Apostle Church of Christ in God delivered the invocation and Mr. Pritchett led in the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

Mr. Pritchett issued the oath of office to newly-elected Council Member Kim Adkins and re-elected Council Member Gene Teague.

Mr. Pritchett called for nominations for Mayor. Danny Turner nominated Kim Adkins for Mayor, seconded by Kimble Reynolds. Mark Stroud nominated Gene Teague for Mayor. Kimble Reynolds made a motion and Gene Teague seconded motion to close the nominations. The following votes were taken for Mayor: (1) Kim Adkins for Mayor—3 votes for Adkins--Reynolds, aye; Turner, aye; and Adkins, aye. (2) Gene Teague for Mayor—2 votes for Teague--Stroud, aye; Teague, aye.

Mr. Pritchett declared Kim Adkins as the new Mayor of the City of Martinsville and issued the oath of office to the new Mayor. Mr. Pritchett then turned the meeting over to Mayor Adkins who asked for nominations for Vice Mayor. Danny Turner nominated Kimble Reynolds for Vice Mayor. Gene Teague nominated Mark Stroud for Vice Mayor. A motion to close the nominations was made by Gene Teague and seconded by Danny Turner. The following votes were taken for Vice Mayor: (1) Kimble Reynolds for Vice Mayor—3 votes for Reynolds--Reynolds, aye; Turner, aye; and Adkins, aye. (2) Mark Stroud for Vice Mayor—2 votes for Stroud--Stroud, aye; Teague, aye. Mayor Adkins announced the new Vice Mayor as Kimble Reynolds and Mr. Pritchett issued the oath of office to Vice Mayor Kimble Reynolds.

Council members made brief remarks offering congratulations to Mayor and Vice Mayor.

On a motion by Gene Teague, seconded by Danny Turner, with a 5-0 vote, Council agreed to the current meeting schedule of second and fourth Tuesday evenings at 7:30 P.M.

There being no further business to come before Council during their organizational meeting, Mayor Adkins adjourned the meeting at 9:15 A.M.
