



Requesting level funding for City's funding of the MHD for 2015 - \$203,010

- Local Health Departments are the shared responsibility of the Locality & State
- Originally, the Local Health Departments were the responsibility of the Locality

2015 Projected Budget Overview:

- Grants \$199,498
- Generated Revenues \$127,977
- General Fund Match (State) \$345,567
- Requested City Funding \$203,010
- Total Projected Revenues \$876,052

Leverage of Funds Provided by the City:

- Salaries & Benefits \$735,970
- Fixed Costs (Rent, Utilities, IT, etc) \$140,082
- COOP + Revenues + Grants + City Finding = Total Revenues of \$876,052
- For every \$1 from City, the MHD is generating an additional \$3.32
