



**CITY OF MARTINSVILLE POLICE DEPT  
REQUEST FOR SEALED BID

Sealed bids will be received until **2:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 9, 2016** by the City of Martinsville Police Department to purchase (2) Two, 2016 or current year 4WD Chevrolet Tahoe **Police Pursuit** Vehicles PPV 9C1, to be used as Canine Units, as per the enclosed specifications. Sealed bids will be received in the office of the Purchasing Manager, Karen Mays, Central Warehouse, 990 Fishel Street in Martinsville, Va. 24112-3248. Bids also may be mailed or sent by FedEx, UPS to the Fishel Street address. Place "Chevrolet Tahoe" on the lower left hand corner of the envelope and bid due date of 08/09/16 2:00 p.m.

It is the responsibility of the offeror to ensure that their proposal reach the appropriate office prior to the close time on the bid. Response received after the date and closing will be considered non-responsive. Bids will not be accepted via fax machine or internet e-mail.

Quote F.O.B. Martinsville, Va. Freight Prepaid and Allowed. Delivery schedule may be used in tabulating and awarding this bid.

The Doors and Top will be White. The Hood, Fenders and Rear Quarter Panels are Black. Vehicles must be delivered with this panda bear look, no exceptions. We will leave it up to you to determine how to give us this preference. Please let us know if you plan to paint or wrap the vehicle for this look.

The City Police Department has chosen the Chevrolet Tahoe as the vehicle of choice. The Chevrolet Tahoe is pursuit rated and will accommodate the K-9 kennel equipment that is stored in the rear of the vehicle. The K-9 kennel that fits the Tahoe provides more area for the K-9 as well as equipment storage in the rear.

**STANDARD BASE VEHICLE FEATURES**

**4 WD Chevrolet Tahoe Police Package Vehicles (PPV 9C1)**

**This specification is for 2016 or most current model year, Chevrolet Tahoe 4 WD Police Pursuit Vehicles (PPV). The City prefers not to wait until September of this year for the new models.** The vehicles shall be the manufacturer's "Police Pursuit" model as indicated and shall meet all requirements of these minimum specifications. The specifications are written to meet the needs of the Virginia State Police; however, the contract resulting from this bid will be made available for use by any law enforcement agency, institutions of higher education, public bodies and other entities authorized to use the contract by the Code of Virginia. The product shall exhibit exceptional handling, performance, stability and maneuverability at both normal and high speeds.

**The requirements below are for VIRGINIA'S BASE VEHICLE which may differ from the Manufacturer's Standard Base Vehicles. Vehicles and equipment bid must conform to the Base**

**Vehicle requirements contained herein and as required in all solicitation documents** Standard features may not be deleted unless specifically indicated by a specification herein.

All components, unless otherwise required by these specifications, shall be the standard or optional equipment specifically advertised and installed by the manufacturer for the police vehicle which the bidder proposes to furnish. The source of information in determining whether or not the equipment is specifically advertised for the vehicle being offered shall be the manufacturer's published police vehicle literature. It should be noted that certain features may be available only to the Virginia State Police.

All options or accessories installed upon the vehicle shall be engineered, designed, or certified by the manufacturer of the vehicle to be compatible with all components, give dependable service, and not degrade the handling, performance, safety or appearance of the vehicle. The term "heavy duty" as used in these specifications shall mean that the item to which the term is applied shall exceed the usual quality, quantity, or capacity supplied with standard production vehicles.

Shall be installed on vehicle, at the following minimum standards;

- a) Noise suppression (including resistor type) spark plugs, coils and wires.
- b) One inch braided bonding straps in the following locations.
  - I. Front & Rear of muffles to undercarriage.
  - II. Tail pipe to undercarriage at rear bracket.
  - III. Each side of hood at hinge point.
  - IV. Each side of rear liftgate at hinge points.
  - V. Rear of engine to body at firewall.

- 35 Noise Suppression
- The vehicle must operate at all speeds with no harmful interference to the performance of the installed public safety equipment (that includes radar, radar detector detectors, lidar, commercial voice and data wireless, 802.11, Bluetooth, mobile computer, GPS receiver, license plate reader, camera system, wireless microphone, wireless video, and private land mobile radios). A patrol vehicle may have a radar on various frequencies, commercial wireless voice and data, high-band VHF (150-173 MHz) and low band VHF (39-46 MHz) 700 MHz band (716-806 MHz) and 800 MHz band (806-854 MHz) two-way radios installed. The vehicle's performance or operation must not be degraded due to the operation of the 125 watt transmitters along with all the other transmitters operating simultaneously. The public safety receivers may not be operationally degraded due to electromagnetic or radio frequency emission from the vehicle. The mfg warranties Electromagnetic Interference (EMI) and Electromagnetic Compatibility (EMC) for a period of at least three years.
- Noise Suppression components in the vehicles' electrical subsystems shall be original equipment from the mfg. and not aftermarket. The vehicle must be compatible with the Commonwealth's Statewide Radio (STARS) system with no interference.

## **NEGOTIATION**

**a. City, Engineer, and apparent low bidder together will review the project and attempt to find mutually agreeable proposed changes that will effectively reduce the cost of the project.**

**b. Apparent low bidder will present reasonably documented and substantiated proposed deductions in project cost for each potential project change, which will allow City to evaluate each proposed deduction.**

**c. The parties will attempt to negotiate and sign a reasonable contract for the entire project, the price of which does not exceed available funds.**

**The City reserves the right to accept or reject any and all bids, to waive any informalities, and to award these vehicles as determined to be in the best interest of the City of Martinsville. Availability of vehicles may be used in tabulating this bid.**
