



## Official Voting Information

**General Election & Special Elections:  
President/Vice President; U.S. Senate; House of Representatives 16<sup>th</sup> District;  
City Council (3 seats); Constitutional Amendments (2)**

**Election Date: November 3, 2020**

**Voter Registration Deadline: Tuesday, October 13, 2020**

The Constitution of Virginia requires that you be registered in the precinct in which you live in order to be qualified to vote.

- Qualified residents who will be 18 years of age on or before November 3<sup>rd</sup> may register and vote.
- It is not necessary to re-register if there are no changes in your information.

**Virginia now has no-excuse in-person and by-mail voting:**

Elections & Voter Registration office at 55 W Church Street, RM 122, has voting machines ready for in-person voting; Monday through Friday Office hours 8:30-11:00 AM; 12 Noon-5 PM.

- COVID-19 Safe Practices Inside Office & Municipal Building: Social Distancing & Mask Required.
- Bring **one** valid form of ID to vote In-Person Absentee.
- **Tuesday, 10/23/2020, 5 PM:** Deadline for submitting Vote by Mail application to Registrar's Office for ballot by mail. On-line request for ballot by mail: [elections.virginia.gov/absentee](http://elections.virginia.gov/absentee)
- **Saturday, October 24, 2020 and October 31, 2020,** 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM office open for the convenience of registered voters who wish to vote in-person or curbside.

**Election Day, Tuesday, 11/3/2020 – Voters vote at registered precinct.**

- Polls Open 6 AM – 7 PM —valid Photo ID required.
- All polling places are accessible to voters with special needs.
